FORMAT FOR APPLICATION

1. Title of proposed research project.
2. Name of Supervisor/s.
3. Name of Department/s.
4. Brief review of the field which covers the proposed project. This should be written by the applicant and be limited to 300-500 words, i.e. not more than two double spaced typed A4 pages. The applicant may consult with the supervisor to obtain important references, and for advice on the final presentation of the review.
5. Proposed project. This section should not exceed 600 words and should be written by the applicant with the close co-operation of the supervisor. It should not only address what you propose to do, but why the project is necessary, and what benefit(s) you expect to result. All relevant information concerning availability of any necessary facilities etc should be included.
6. If the proposed project requires ethical approval, supervisors must ensure that any such approval has been obtained before work on the project commences.

Send eight copies of the application, the letter of support from the proposed supervisor (endorsed where applicable by the departmental head) and your certified academic record to:

VALUE: \$4,500

The Child Accident Prevention Foundation wishes to award a number of student scholarships for the forthcoming summer break. Projects must relate in some way to child accident prevention and preference will be given to those that will be of immediate practical benefit to the community.

The scholarships are open to both undergraduate and postgraduate students.

The scope for projects is extremely wide, and includes such possibilities as:

- the design of a practical counter-measure to a recognised hazard
- field testing of a specific hypothesis
- preparation of educational material for use by children
- literature reviews
- critical analysis of existing prevention strategies (including legislative provisions)
- critical reviews of childhood unintentional injury campaigns
- critical analysis of media reporting of childhood unintentional injuries
- analysis of the role of the environment in childhood unintentional injuries
