

Safe2Go website launched!

Safe2Go is New Zealand's national child restraint use training programme and have recently launched their new website www.safe2go.co.nz.

The website will give Safe2Go trainers and technicians access to resources such as Safe2Go posters, child restraints save lives brochures, Safe2Go technicians manual and the Safe2Go newsletter.

Parents and caregivers will also have access to information and advice on choosing a child restraint, the correct use of child restraints, child restraints and the law, and how to find a Safe2Go technician in their area.

Safe2Go, a joint initiative between NZ Transport Agency and ACC, funds Safe2Go trainers throughout New Zealand to train technicians in the correct installation of child restraints.

Safe2Go technicians include:

- loan scheme operators
- child restraint retailers
- New Zealand Police
- mechanics
- injury prevention consultants
- road safety co-ordinators
- anyone who fits or checks child restraints on a regular basis.

The goal of Safe2Go is to improve the standard of use and installation of child restraints in New Zealand through improving the competence of targeted groups of people who advise parents and caregivers in fitting or checking the installation of child restraints.
